Trek Option	The Trek Option is open to participants in the Ultimate Owasippe Adventure Week, and is an additional \$10 per person in addition to the UOA fee. A minimum of 2 adult leaders total across the 2 crews must participate in the Trek Option for Scouts to participate. OSR will transfer the appropriate breakfasts and dinners to the sites listed. OSR will provide tents at each site but will not provide individual equipment such as backpacks, sleeping bags, etc. This option allows the participants to convert the UOA program into a week long trek program.
