



## Pathway to Adventure Council Boy Scouts of America Training Opportunities Guiding you to guide youth.

These courses are provided to help you better understand how to guide and develop the youth of your Dens, Packs, Troops, Teams, Crews, and Posts.

**Everyone is required to take Youth Protection training.** It is available online specifically for Cub Scout and Boy Scout Leaders (Y01), for Venturing and Sea Scout Leaders (Y02), and for Exploring Leaders (Y03). You may access it and other online training at <http://my.scouting.org>. Logon and click on the *BSA Learn Center* logo. The page has an instructional video and a list of position-specific modules. Online courses for the minimum required training consist of several modules of 10-15 minutes each and may be taken at your convenience.

Check the calendar at <http://pathwaytoadventure.org/ptacalendar> for specific information. To see only training programs, click on *Categories* in the upper left of the calendar, click *No Categories* to uncheck everything, then click the box next to *Training*. Click *Apply Filter* and the calendar will display only scheduled training courses.

Circumstances may cause some of the following dates to change, so check the calendar.

Courses listed as **required** are the minimum training needed for the listed position. When you complete those courses, you are entitled to wear the *Trained* patch under your position patch.

**For Den Leaders and Assistants: (required)** C42 *Cub Scout Den Leader & Assistant Position Specifics Training*. This course provides Tiger, Wolf, Bear and Webelos Den Leaders with the information and tools they need to conduct successful den meetings. **9/23/17; 9/30/17; 10/7/17; 10/17/17; 10/28/17; 11/4/17\*; 11/11/17; 12/2/17; online**

**For Cubmasters and Assistants: (required)** C40 *Cubmaster & Assistant Position Specific Training*. This course provides Cubmasters with the information and tools they need to successfully lead a Cub Scout pack. **9/23/17; 9/30/17; 10/7/17; 10/17/17; 10/28/17; 11/4/17\*; 11/11/17; 12/2/17; online**

**For Any Cub Scout Leaders: (Completion of this course is mandatory for at least one adult on a Pack overnighter.)** C32 *BALOO-Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation*. This course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for those leaders who are interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. **7/29/17; 10/21/17; 11/4\*/17; 11/11/17**

**For Pack Committees: (required)** C60 *Pack Committee Challenge*. The purpose of the Pack Committee Challenge is to familiarize pack committee members with the various responsibilities of the individual members of the committee as well as the committee as a whole. **10/28/17; 11/4\*/17; online**

**For Chartered Organization Representatives: (required)** D72 *Training the Chartered Organization Representative*. The Chartered Organization Representative (COR) is head of the "Scouting department" in the organization, and as such the responsibilities of the units and leadership is ultimately the COR's responsibility. Learn how to ensure that the chartered organization's Scouting program succeeds. **11/4\*/17; 11/8/17; 12/7/17**

11/4\*/17 shows courses offered as part of the Council Training Academy

**For Scoutmasters and Assistants: (required)** S24 *Scoutmaster & Assistant Specific Training*. The course provides Scoutmasters with the basic information and tools they need to lead successful Boy Scout troops. **11/4\*/17; 11/11/17; 11/18/17; 12/2/17; 12/9/17**

**For Scoutmasters and Assistants: (required)** S11 *IOLS - Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills*. This hands on course provides adult leaders the practical skills they need to lead scouts in the outdoors. **9/30/17 – 10/1/17; 10/21/17 – 10/22/17 (weekend courses)**

**For Troop Committees: (required)** WS10 *Troop Committee Challenge*. The purpose of the Troop Committee Challenge is to familiarize troop committee members with the various responsibilities of the individual members of the committee as well as the committee as a whole. **11/4\*/17; online**

**For Venturing Crew Advisors and Associates: (required)** P21 *Venturing Leader Specific Training*. The course introduces the responsibilities, opportunities, and resources that will ensure a successful Venturing crew leadership experience. **11/4\*/17; 12/16/17; online**

**For Venturing Crew Committees: (required)** WS12 *Crew Committee Challenge*. Participants will discuss the roles and responsibilities of a Venturing crew committee and how to keep positively engaged in the functions of a successful crew. **12/16/17; online**

**Exploring Leaders: (required)** L01 *Explorer Leader Adult Basic Training*. This training is designed to introduce adult Explorer post leaders and participating organization members to the basic information needed to organize and operate a post. **11/4\*/17; online**

**For all who have completed their Basic Leader Training: (advanced)** A90 *Wood Badge*. By use of a variety of learning styles, including lectures, demonstrations, group discussions, and hands on exercises, participants will learn contemporary leadership and team building concepts to develop the skills and tools needed to provide the youth members of their organizations the highest quality scouting experience possible. **9/22/17 – 9/24/17 and 10/13/17 – 10/15/17 (A 3-day weekend) Watch for**

**For all Potential Trainers: (supplemental)** D70 *Train-the-Trainer (Fundamentals of Training)*. The course introduces teaching techniques and skills to new Scout trainers but is also designed to help all Scouters, regardless of their experience, present effective training. **12/9/17**

**For all Potential Trainers: (supplemental)** H96 *Trainer's EDGE*. While the Trainer's EDGE is a required train-the-trainer course for Wood Badge and NYLT staffs, it is also for other trainers wishing to enhance their training and presentation skills. **To be determined**

**Boy Scouts and Venturers: (supplemental)** C31 *Den Chief Training*. Boy Scouts and Venturers who wish to become den chiefs will take this course to learn den chief responsibilities and tasks, and the den chief's relationship to the adult den leaders and how that relates to the den chief's activities with the den. **9/30/17; 10/1/17; 10/7/17; 11/4\*/17**

**Boy Scouts and Venturers: (advanced)** S78 *NYLT. National Youth Leadership Training* is an exciting, action-packed program designed for councils to provide youth members with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home troops. **Usually offered in early summer. Watch for further announcements.**
