## **Training Recognition for Unit Leaders**



**Minimum Required Training.** All leaders are required to complete Youth Protection Training (YPT) every two years. There are specific courses for Venturing and Exploring leaders. Everyone else should complete the standard version. All versions may be completed online at <a href="http://my.scouting.org">http://my.scouting.org</a>.

There are specific courses for leadership positions. Unless noted otherwise, these may be taken in a classroom or online. The recognition for leaders who complete YPT and their position specific training is the *Trained* Leader Emblem.
