Important information – please read!

- Merit Badges will not be taught at this clinic (with the exception of Fingerprinting).
- Scouts must be prepared:
 - ✓ Wear a Class A uniform.
 - ✓ Bring a blue merit badge card with specific merit badge identified & signed by a Unit Leader.
 - ✓ If the work is completed and documented as outlined in the 2017 merit badge requirements, a merit badge counselor may sign off on completed items at his/her discretion.
 - ✓ Proof of completion must be brought by the Scout to the clinic. Examples include but are not limited to: instruments, presentations, service hour completion, comparison shopping documentation, first aid kit, etc.
- Working to get some of the requirements of a Merit Badge signed-off is encouraged! You don't have to complete it at the clinic.
