



### **It's here! It's here!**

The new Pathway to Adventure Council shoulder patch for National Youth Leadership Training, NYLT, participants and staff is designed and ready to go for the 2019 course!!!

NYLT is a one-week advanced leadership training experience for Scouts who want to become more effective in leading and teaching. In order to attend participants must be 14 years old or 13 years old and have completed 8th grade. Boy members of a Scouts BSA troop must be First Class rank or above. In 2019 only, to allow new girl troops to have trained youth leaders, girls registered in Scouts BSA may attend NYLT without first achieving the First Class rank provided they meet the age requirements and complete Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST) with their Troop. Girls who are registered Venturers do not need to achieve the First Class rank, but must attend Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews (ILSC) prior to participating in NYLT.

The 2019 PTAC course will be held at Owasippe Scout Reservation in Twin Lake, Michigan. There will be two sessions, one beginning June 16 and one beginning June 23. [Registration will open online on January 1.](#)

Fees for the 2019 NYLT course will be \$280, which includes transportation from one of several locations within the Pathway to Adventure Council borders to and from the Owasippe Scout Reservation. "Camp Cash" may be used and Scholarships are available. Don't delay and avoid the \$50 late fee to be assessed on late applications and outstanding balances.

If using "Camp Cash" get your voucher number from your unit leader to use at registration. Scholarship forms are available from the PTAC website [online course description page](#) and [training menu option](#), and will be available on the [registration page](#). The scholarship application deadline is April 15, 2019 with awards announced shortly thereafter. Scouts must accept the award for it to be applied to their registration fee.
