



# Jungle Adventure Day Camp



Jungle Adventure Day Camp is an outdoor program filled with fun and learning for youth entering first through fifth grade in the fall. Tiger, Wolf, and Bear Scouts will enjoy this adventure discovering nature around them while. Webeols Scouts should attend the overnight program called [Webelos Camp](#). Scouts may invite a friend or sibling who is not a Scout o attend camp with them. If a friend or sibling is participating their parent must attend, unless the Pack is participating, then the supervision can be part of the Pack supervision of Scouts. Siblings make day camp a family event and Inviting friends and prospects to Day Camp is a great way to introduce non-Scouts to the fun of Scouting.

For 2019 there are two Jungle Adventure Day Camp formats:

- A **one-day** Jungle Adventure Day Camp - Saturday, June 15 in Palatine. (\$25 by May 31)
- A **five-day** Jungle Adventure Day Camp with pre and post care options - July 15 through 19 in Schaumburg. (\$135 by May 1)

Camp cash may be used to pay for day camp. The camp cash code provided to the Scout is to be entered when making the online registration. You may register as a pack or individually.

- **Register as a Pack** - A leader to Scout ratio of 1:10 (5 day) or 1:5 (Saturday) with 2 deep leadership is required. TIGERS must attend with their adult partners (ratio for Tigers is always 1:1)
- **Register individually** - A parent MUST attend with Scout.

**Adults:** Adults register for reduced (\$7) fee and will supervise and assist Cub Scouts as program helpers. They must be Youth Protection trained and submit trained certificate at time of registration. Training is available online at [my.Scouting.org](http://my.Scouting.org)

**Den Chiefs** may attend at the reduced adult registration rate (\$7), but do not count for the leadership ratio. With approval from their Troop leadership, Den Chiefs may count their time as service hours.

**BSA Health Form** Parts A and B (no doctor signature needed) are required for all youth and adults attending day camp. Link to [BSA Health Form](#)
