Scout's derby car. Cub Scouts should bring their pinewood derby kit and design then watch it turned into their dream car under the skilled hands of the Rolling Meadows GYC Woodshop woodworkers. Leave the sawdust behind and take home a car ready to paint.

A Cub Scout should plan to spend about 1 ½ hours at the clinic to complete design, cut out and test car assembly.

A scale and test ramp will be available to assure cars meet the needed weight and clearance specifications.
