



## National Youth Leadership Training

All Scouts BSA and Venturers should complete National Youth Leadership Training, NYLT, as part of their development as value based leaders. The NYLT course centers around the concepts of what a leader must **BE**, what a leader must **KNOW**, and what a leader must **DO**. The key elements are taught with a clear focus on **HOW TO**. The skills come alive during the week as the team goes on a Quest for the Meaning of Leadership.

In order to attend, participants must be Scouts at least 13 years old. Members of a Scouts BSA troop must have earned the First Class rank. For summer 2019 only, girls registered in Scouts BSA may attend NYLT without achieving the First Class rank, if they complete Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST). Girls registered as Venturers do not need to achieve the First Class rank, but must complete Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews (ILSC) prior to participating in NYLT.

The 2019 PTAC course will be held twice at Owasippe Scout Reservation in Twin Lake, Michigan.

- Course one is Sunday June 16 through Saturday June 22
- Course two is Sunday June 23 through Saturday June 29

Fees for the 2019 NYLT course are \$280, which includes transportation from one of several locations within the Pathway to Adventure Council borders to and from the Owasippe Scout Reservation, food and course materials. Scholarships are available and "Camp Cash" may be used. Register soon and avoid the \$50 late fee assessed on late applications and outstanding balances.

If using "Camp Cash" get your voucher number from your unit leader to use at registration.

Scholarship:

- Forms for Scouts in financial need are available from the PTAC website [online course description page](#) and must be filed by April 15, 2019. Awards will be announced shortly thereafter, and Scouts must accept the award for it to be applied to their registration fee.
- Fearless Girl Scholarship – This scholarship covers the National Youth Leader Training, NYLT, registration fee for all eligible female Scouts. There are no forms to complete or file, but female Scouts need to be eligible, register for and complete NYLT. Here's how it works:
  - 1 Eligible Scouts are females qualified to attend NYLT
  - 2 Register online and make a payment of ½ the registration fee. (For summer 2019, that amount is \$140.) The scholarship fund will pay the outstanding registration fee balance **and** refund the registration fee paid upon course and course evaluation completion.

Fine Print: The Fearless Girl Scholarship covers the NYLT registration fee only. Additional shirts ordered and personal expenses are not included. At conclusion of the course, the NYLT staff adviser will compile a list of the female Scouts who completed the course. Those Scouts will be asked to complete and return a survey for the donors who generously provided the funds for them to attend NYLT. Once the survey is returned, the registration fee paid will be refunded. Reimbursements may take three to four weeks to process.
