Wood Badge is the ultimate leadership training program for adult leaders of the Boy Scouts of America. Established in 1919 by Robert Baden-Powell, Scouting's founder, Wood Badge has been the training ground for hundreds of thousands of Scouters around the world. Building on the past, understanding the present, and looking to the future, Wood Badge stands ready to help you provide leadership for Scouting and America.

The Wood Badge Course brings together leaders from all areas of Scouting – Cub Scouting, Boy Scouting, Venturing – and BSA professional staff. Reflecting the best of more than a century of Scouting experience, the course also draws upon the most current leadership models used by corporate America, academic circles, and successful outdoor leadership organizations throughout the country. It draws from a wide range of sources within and beyond the bounds of Scouting to present the latest in leadership theory and team development.

Wood Badge is a six day course, offered as two sessions of three days. As an attendee, you begin your Wood Badge experience with other leaders from around the Council as Cub Scouts, then bridge into Boy Scouting and form patrols for the remainder of the program.
