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WHAT IS SCOUTS BSA?

Scouts BSA is the traditional Scouting experience where youth ages 11-17 can have amazing adventures in the great outdoors, develop a love of service by volunteering in their community, boost leadership skills through fun and exciting challenges, and create memories of a lifetime!

Scouts complete rank requirements and earn merit badges that introduce them to new skills, hobbies, and possible careers. With over 135 merit badges—covering topics like sports, arts, business, science, and personal development—there's something for every interest. Each step in advancement builds toward the prestigious Eagle Scout rank, a nationally recognized award that reflects dedication, leadership, and service.

WHY SCOUTING

SERVICE - Scouting builds leaders by instilling values of responsibility and service. Former Scouts have gone on to serve on corporate boards, in the White House, and even walk on the moon. The foundation built in Scouting helps members make good decisions throughout life.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT - Scouts practice leadership every day! Learning to listen, be fair, stay organized, delegate, and encourage others. They discover how to accept feedback, work as a team, and most importantly, enjoy the process of leading.

PERSONAL GROWTH - Guided by the slogan Do a Good Turn Daily, Scouts learn to give back without expecting anything in return. These habits build character while teaching responsibility for their communities and the environment.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

Scouts BSA is organized into troops, a group of youth who meet regularly—often weekly—with adult support. Troops plan monthly outdoor activities like camping or hiking, along with service projects and community events. Families can choose the troop that offers the best fit for their schedule and interests.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

There is an annual registration and insurance fee to join Scouting. Please contact your local unit for more information.

There are also one-time uniform costs and nominal activity fees that may be charged by your local group.

These costs may be offset by fundraising and financial support for those who qualify.
