

<p><b>EARN YOUR STRIPES</b> Objective Scout will Achieve:</p>	<p>In this adventure, Tigers will learn about what it means to wear Tiger orange. The color orange represents warmth, cheer, enthusiasm, creativity, and energy. Tigers are proud to wear the color orange; they like to show their enthusiasm by helping others and by using their energy to complete tasks. Helping others provides the opportunity to build self-esteem, give goodwill, and create a cheerful attitude. The warmth in the color orange is shared by using proper manners when speaking to others.</p>

<p>Instruction for Activity 3</p>	<p>Play some fun music, and have Tigers and adult partners mill about the “party.” After a brief time, the leader stops the music. Have each Tiger, in turn, draw a card and respond or act out their card appropriately for the scenario.</p>
