Activities during meeting:	1) Use 2D materials to make an art piece 2) Use digital media to make an online art piece 3) Use Play Doh to create a 3D art piece. 4) Make a final art piece using both 2D and 3D media.
Instruction for Activity 1	Draw or paint an original picture out-of-doors, using the art materials you prefer. Frame the picture for your room or home.
Instruction for Activity 2	Using MS Paint or another free digital media tool, make six original designs using straight lines, curved lines, or both. Try saving it in different formats (.jpg, .bmp, .gif). Record the difference between the digital formats.
Instruction for Activity 3	Use clay to sculpt a simple object.
Instruction for Activity 4	Make an art construction, using all of the art materials at your disposal.
