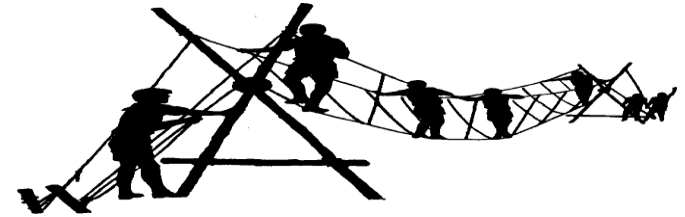




2020 / 2021 Webelos-to-Scout Transition



- **Packs and Troops:**
 - How are you managing and preparing for your Webelos to Scout Transition?
 - The future of our troops depends on you!!!
- **PACKS – This year, as with all aspects of Scouting, creativity will be required for:**
 - Working to have your Webelos Dens complete requirements and graduate to a Scout Troop in Spring
 - Developing a relationship with the Scouts BSA Troops within your area for visits, Den Chiefs & support for Advancement
 - Participating in Webelos outdoor event: Examples are Winter Blast, Polar Prowl, and/or a Klondike Derby – watch for updates in your District Newsletter or PTAC Website & Calendar!
 - Planning a meaningful Crossover ceremony (perhaps virtually) with the help of the Troops and the Order of the Arrow
 - Assisting Webelos leaders to graduate to the Troop as a Committee Member or Asst. Scoutmaster
- **TROOPS – Can you find a safe way to:**
 - Encourage Scouts to become Den Chiefs to support Cub Scout Packs
 - Work with the PLC to incorporate Webelos outings or activities into your planning.
 - Participate in Winter Blast, Polar Prowl, and/or Klondike Derby – watch for updates in your District Newsletter or PTAC Website & Calendar!
 - Request Webelos contact info from Packs, Unit Commissioner or District Membership Chair & include them on your Troop newsletter email list
 - Assist Troop Leadership (youth & adult) for visit of Webelos, help with Webelos and Arrow of Light requirements, and discuss becoming Scouts_BSA and the youth led Troop
 - Prepare and distribute a Troop information packet for Webelos parents, using the 5th & 6th Grade Webelos Lists
