Council Printed Fliers

PTAC has created a set of fliers that units can get printed that feature our recruitment theme of Race into Scouting as well as space for units to provide customized information.

These fliers can be used in a variety of formats. Talk to your school(s) to see if they will pass out fliers, post them on Community Boards throughout the community, have them available at Back to School Night/Community Festivals/Recruitment Events, and many others. Think outside the box and get creative. It is also possible to get a digital copy of the flier(s) to use electronically, just add that in the order.

These fliers are ordered through Carl Monk at carl.monk@scouting.org. Please see the below instructions on how to place an order.

1. Pick the design that best fits your unit and location. The fliers are numbered, specify which flier(s) you would like to order.
 - A. If you are a Family Pack, use the flier that features both male and female youth. Fliers are also available in English and Spanish.

2. Each flier has a space to add unit specific information. Specify exactly what you would like to include in your customizable section.

A. This content should focus on the 4 Ws: Who, What, Where, and When

B. I will take care of the formatting to ensure it looks good and fits correctly, but I am not proofreading your content, so double check before you send in your request.

3. Specify how many fliers that you want. I can provide a mix, especially if you want some English and some Spanish. Just ensure you specify exactly what you are looking for.

4. Let me know who to contact to pick up the fliers when they are completed.

A. The fliers are printed in Chicago and we use that printer for a lot of different print jobs, so plan on fliers taking a week from when you order to when they are ready for pick up.

A.If you have a last minute order, call me and I can see what we can do.

WHAT IS CUB SCOUTS?


Cub Scouts is a fun-filled program for boys and girls, grades K-5.

Scouts go on amazing adventures while learning new skills, making friends, helping others, and building self-esteem.

WHY SCOUTING?

Convenience - Families today are busier than ever, and with less free time! In Cub Scouts, all siblings (grade K-5) can participate in the same pack program.

Scouting Builds Positive Character - Tufts University worked with Scouting over 3 years to measure character attributes of both Scouts and non-Scouts. In the beginning, there were no significant differences in character attributes. By the end, the differences were striking in several areas.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

Your family will become part of a local group called a pack that meets once a month for adventures, activities, and recognition of achievements.

The pack you choose is up to you. While there are likely many packs in your area, parents often decide to join the one closest to their child's school.

Your Cub Scout will be a part of a smaller group, within the pack, based on grade and gender, that meets a few times each month for age-specific activities.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

There is an annual registration and insurance fee to join Scouting, which is prorated from the time you sign up through the end of the year. Please contact your local unit for more information.

There are also one-time uniform costs and nominal activity fees that may be charged by your local group.

These costs may be offset by fundraising and financial support for those who qualify.
