Patrol Method	Use of the patrol method (patrol work schedule, patrol leader meetings)
Hazards	Wood tools are stored in the axe yard or trailer. All other hazards are dealt with
No cars in Site	All unauthorized vehicles are parked in designated parking lots
Dining Table	Proper table cleanliness and cleanup
Bulletin Board	Fireguard sheet is posted along with Baden Powell, patrol work schedule, etc...
Fire Guard	Fire guard sheet is filled out, bucket for water is full near the firepit
Tents	Nothing attached to the tents. No damage
Floorboards	Swept and unbroken
Personal Gear	Clothing and gear neatly stored
Kybo	Cleaned and swept daily. Sinks and urinal cleared out
Grounds and Trail	No litter and no personal gear
Damage	Nothing is broken purposefully
SPL Meetings	Attend the SPL meeting that happens at 1:15pm at the North Lodge
