Emergency Care in Remote Locations, this course provides information on how to handle common injuries and illnesses when medical care is an hour away or more. This class will teach you what to look for and what to do in the event of an emergency, and directs you to the most appropriate type of care.

- Must attend both Friday and Saturday classes to complete training. This not an overnight event.
