Spark Plug Award	This award recognizes someone who has been able to take an idea and produce the necessary spark to make a specific activity or event successful. Please consider a different award for a leader who consistently does a great job for your unit.		
H Allen Pederson Scoutmaster of the Year	Awarded to a registered, seasoned Scoutmaster who exemplifies Scouting's ideals of character, fitness, and citizenship and who has mentored a significant number of his/her Scouts in their advancement to the rank of Eagle.		
Cubmaster of the Year	Award to a registered, seasoned Cubmaster who exemplifies Scouting's ideals of character, fitness, and citizenship and who has mentored a significant number of his/her Scouts in their advancement.		
Golden Oak Award	The award is available to registered Scouters who render service of an outstanding nature at the unit or district level.		
Lynn Darin Outstanding Eagle Scout of the Year Award	To recognize Eagle Scouts who continue to participate in Scouting after attaining the rank of Eagle Scout. The nominee must have earned the Eagle Award while a member of a Scout Troop in the Thunderbird District and served as an Eagle Scout for a minimum of 6 months at the time of nomination. (Nominees may be 18 years old at the time of the award provided that at least 6 months of active involvement as an Eagle Scout has occurred.)
