- Criminal Background Check*
- Medication logs and original bottles





The Paperwork - Scouts BSA & OSR

- Roster (if camping as a pack) all scouts and adults
- Proof of Youth Protection Training -EVERY ADULT
- Medical Forms (A, B, Insurance Card)
- Special Dietary Needs form

- 2. If camping as a pack: check in together
- 3. Medical checks and equipment nextdoor at dining tent
- 4. Setup campsite
- 5. Dinner and Leaders meeting
